The project aims at the establishment and development of the Center for Research on Circular Economy of Materials (CVOM), connecting research organizations with representatives of the application sphere in solving complex research topics in the field of material flows, circular economy and waste, with a focus on solving complex projects requiring thorough monitoring of the current state, changes and analysis of social and environmental needs with the aim of achieving practically usable results. These results will then be optimized and verified in practice, so that they can be implemented in a broader context at the national level. The key ambition of CVOM is to bring proposals for system solutions, the feasibility of which has been practically verified and is based on the real possibilities of the available industrial and technological base at the national level in the context of the need to ensure environmental, but also economic sustainability and competitiveness of the Czech Republic.
